HEALTHCARE

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We at BVS School Healthcare Clinic are extra careful about the safety and health of our pupils, particularly in response to Covid-19 pandemic. We are, therefore taking concrete steps to ensure safety and wellbeing of our children as they attend to School. BVS has added a well-equipped specially prepared room to accommodate sick children to ensure proper spacing and effective management.



Our healthcare providers have all been screened for Covid-19. They will be working with Personal Protective Gear. They are trained to sanitize hands before and after dispensing medicines. Disposable bed sheets and paper towels are in place.

Our school clinic sops are as follows:



- Staff should wear face masks and gloves all the time.
- Check temperature of every student who enters the clinic.



- Guide students to cough n sneeze in their elbow.



- Perform proper hand hygiene before and after encounter with every student and staff members.

- Clinic should be cleaned immediately when required



Our school clinic sops are as follows:



- Disinfection of the equipment in use, furniture and floor etc. Should be undertaken.

- Frequent use of hand sanitizers by the healthcare providers.



- Children with fever should not be detained in the clinic but should be immediately sent home. They will wait in an isolation in a separate room.

- Minimum number of two students to be allowed in the clinic at a time to ensure social distancing.



- Students to be taught sanitization technique and cough etiquettes.

Some useful advice for parents



- Although we at school clinic regularly monitor your child's health on a regular basis, however do notice any change in temperature, appetite, difficulty in breathing, nausea or vomiting. If you do notice symptoms, report to a health professional as well as to the school. Your immediate reporting will help us take care of any possible transmission of the virus.
- Should you wish to see the school doctor for any reason, kindly make prior appointment through proper channel.
- Do ask your child to bring their water bottle to the school clinic if they need to take medicines. This is an extra measure in terms of safety.
- All asthmatic students may bring their own personal masks for nebulization and leave them in the clinic with their names and class clearly marked.
